
**Compendium of Automatic Morse Code**






## Hopper

When used for cider making, a hopper is a wooden or metal box that collects fruits before they are funnelled down through a chute to the crusher. In old Vermont towns, it was common for the community of growers to share one cider press instead of each farmer purchasing and maintaining his or her own. Come fall, people would cart their apples or pears to the farm that kept the mill, and into the hopper their fruits would go -- often mixing with the products of a neighbouring grower. The Hopper believes that in order to refashion our lives to accommodate the knowledge we have of our environmental crisis, we have a lot of cultural heavy lifting to do. To reacquaint ourselves meaningfully with the natural world we have to turn our interpretive, inquisitive, and inspired faculties upon it.






### Against the Tide

This is a true story that captures the fear and hardships faced by African Americans during a disturbing time in American history the post-Reconstruction period that led to the introduction of Jim Crow laws. Through hard work and determination, Hansford C Bayton would rise from humble beginnings to become the captain and owner of five excursion and mail delivery steamboats that plied the Rappahannock River during the late 1800s and early 1900s. Unusually for an African American, he would acquire wealth and the respect of both blacks and whites. Nevertheless, his boats were burned one by one. But with each malicious burning, and with lynching on the rise, he would build again. This book illuminates a time in American history when the surge of progress made by freedmen was sharply curtailed through the enactment of segregation laws and the activities of the Ku Klux Klan. As a result Hansford C Bayton died poor, but his story is one of dignified courage and determination when faced with overwhelming odds. Truly, he was a man who swam against the tide.




### Aging Disgracefully






### Betrayal in Charleston

If someone you love lets you down, it hurts. Often it is painful for a long time, but nothing is as difficult as being betrayed by a family member. This was Steven Sarkela's experience, but it did not just happen once. It occurred routinely with several family members. Even worse, Steven's betrayals were life altering -- not trivial. One betrayal culminated in his being abducted, tortured, and threatened with death. Steve was a successful developer, investing in high-end South Carolina beachfront properties, with business partners who conspired to steal everything from him -- including his life. And, sadly, his mother and stepfather were key figures in the betrayal and theft. Eventually escaping the torture of his kidnappers, Steven decided to fight back rather than remain a victim. Unfortunately, the local police in Charleston sided with his kidnappers. Eliciting the support of the FBI to bring his kidnappers to justice, Steven became the bait for a sting operation that could have been fatal, but which sent his kidnappers to prison. Because Steven Sarkela's story is real, it is not predictable. This adds considerably to its fascination, but his tale is much more than a chronology of events. It takes you into his inner world, describing how he dealt with massive betrayals, including the post-traumatic stress that followed his torture.








## **Degree of Normal A Woman's Journey Out of Childhood Abuse**






## **Jack Grout A Legacy in Golf**




## **Kathryn Kelly The Moll Behind Machine Gun Kelly (Gangland Mysteries Series)**






## Rochester Lives


## Side-Yard Superhero




## Teaching School is a Scream!




### **Their Lives Before Us**


### **Three-Ring Marriage**

Brian is a survivor of incest, horrible abuse, and the resulting self-indulgence and destructive behaviour, but he was always aware there was a better way. Beginning at an early age Brian saw what was wrong, and instead of saying, I can't, he said, I will. The book also explores Brian's unorthodox family of two wives and seven children with candour and enlightenment. Regardless of a person's belief system, background or family structure, there is something in this book for everyone. Anyone who has ever asked, do I make a difference? should read this book.


## Trigger Warning

Bill Leak's daily cartoons in The Australian newspaper have been variously described as the works of a genius and Australia's most insightful and thought-provoking arbiter of the main story of the day. The book features a host of other insights on the stories of the day, covering a wide range of political and cultural topics and key moments from the year that was.
